Janine Wesselmann is known across four continents and four decades for her parodies of European and American social life. A Cornell University graduate, she has been listed in Who's Who in America, Who's Who in the World, Who's Who of American Women and received the award for outstanding contribution to the arts in Cambridge, England. She is the first American woman to show at the

Museum of Modern Art in Paris and in 1997 was named a cultural ambassador to France. She has been endorsed by governors, senators, ambassadors and princes and her works hang in museums and collections throughout Europe and the United States. In Naples, Janine had 2 one-woman shows at Debruyne Fine Arts and is in the permanent Collection at the von Liebig Art Center. You can see her artwork at The Englishman Fine Art on 5th Ave.
